MAIL-O-GRAPHIC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament will be conducted by the National Women's 500 Club, Inc. for its members. The tournament director will be appointed by the President of the National Women's 500 Club, Inc.
2. An entrant must be a current member of USBC. She must also be a current member of the National 500 Club or may join when her entry is submitted. A bowler may enter by including her \$15.00 lifetime membership dues and application with her tournament entry fee.
3. This tournament will be conducted by submitting USBC certified league scores bowled during the week of November 7, 2010 through November 20, 2010. Only scores bowled November 7 through November 20, 2010 will be accepted.
4. Entrants will use their current sanctioned league average as of date of participation based on a minimum of 12 games in the league from which they are submitting scores. All other will use a 200 average.
5. This tournament will be handicapped at 90% of 200. USBC Certified
6. USBC Rule 319A-2 (10 pin increase provision), 319d (tournament prize winning provision) and 319e (tournament average adjustment) will not apply. U.S.B.C rule 319a3 (reporting incorrect average will apply).
7. An entrant participating in the Senior Division must be 60 prior to October 31, 2010. A copy of identification showing her age must be submitted with her entry. An entrant in the Senior Division may also enter in either of the other divisions where her average applies as a separate entry and as such requires two separate entry forms and the required entry fee.
8. If more than three games are bowled in scheduled league play, the first three games will be used. Traveling leagues bowling six games (two 3-game series) may be entered for either series or both series. Entering both would be two entries and as such would require two entry fees.
9. An entry fee may be submitted for each USBC certified league in which the participant is bowling. Photocopies of the entry form will be accepted. An entrant may, however, cash only once in each division entered.
10. All scores must be bowled in a USBC certified league. Scores bowled in mixed leagues certified by USBC are eligible for this tournament.
11. The prize fund will be returned 100% and will be based on at least one cash award for every five entries in each division. The highest handicapped score bowled (3 games) in each division will be declared Division Champion. In case of a tie for first place, the club may declare Co-Champions with first and second place money divided equally between the two duplicate awards.
12. Photocopies of the recap sheet or computer generated score sheets will be accepted. Recaps must be returned postmarked no later than December 14, 2010
